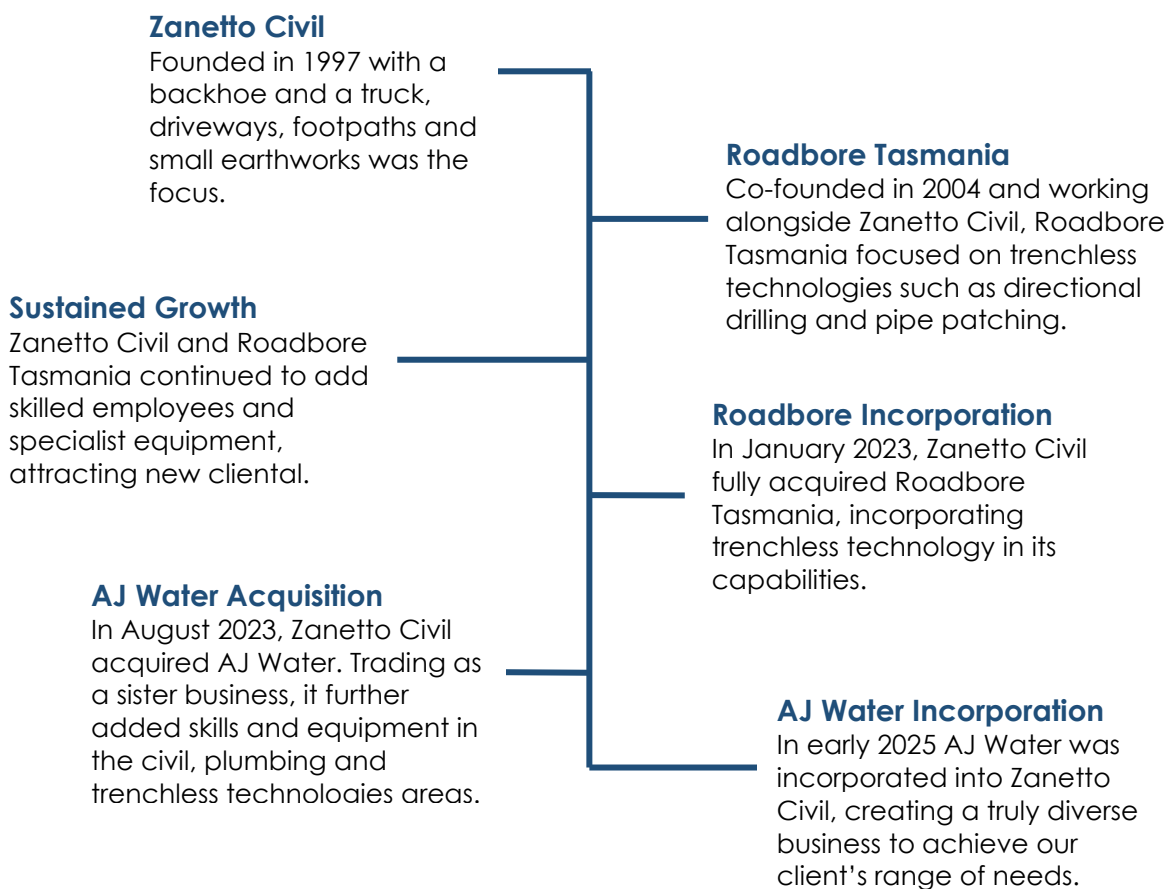

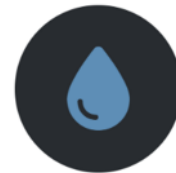


Subdivisions

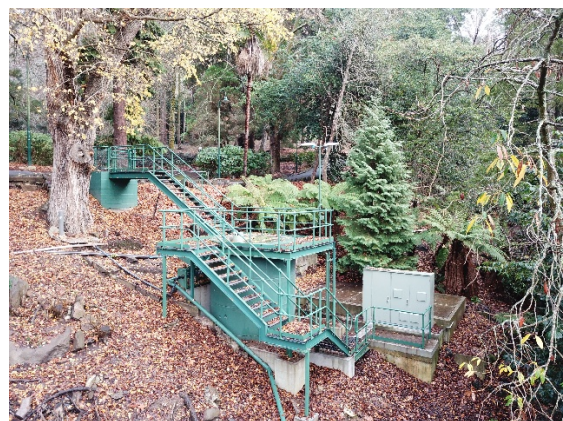

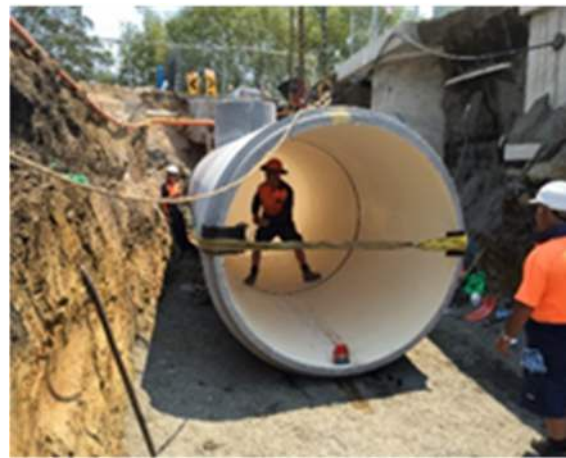

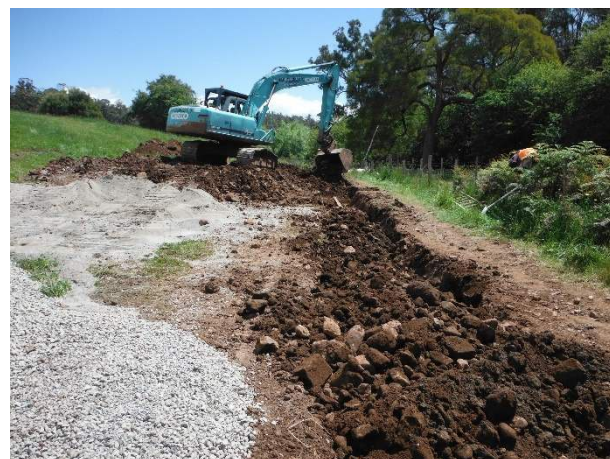
